

2020 High School Seniors Scholarship Program

The Oklahoma AgCredit Scholarship Program provides financial assistance for children of existing members.

The Association will award \$1,000 scholarships to eligible applicants.

Qualifications:

Eligible applicants must:

- 1. Be the child or step-child of an existing Oklahoma AgCredit member (member must be personally liable on the loan).
- 2. Plan to graduate high school in May 2020 and to pursue further education in fall 2020.
- 3. Agree to allow information about their award to be used in publicity materials, if selected.
- 4. Applicants may pursue any major, degree, or certification program at any vocational school, university or college that is in- or out-of-state. Must be enrolled in at least 12 hours or considered "full-time."
- 5. Applicant must attain a minimum of 20 for the ACT composite and/or a 2.5 or higher GPA.

Application process:

- 1. Please complete this application in its entirety, including the essay question.
- 2. With your application, please include a picture for use on the Association's social media accounts and biannual magazine, *Oklahoma Rural Roots*.
- 3. A completed application with high school transcript and photo must be received by June 5, 2020.
- 4. Materials must be submitted via email to:

Make sure you receive a reply to confirm the application was received.

- 5. Applications will be reviewed by the Oklahoma AgCredit Scholarship Committee.
- 6. Scholarships will be awarded providing eligibility is met and the application process is complete.

Scholarship distribution:

- 1. Scholarship recipients will receive a confirmation letter with directions on claiming the scholarship.
- 2. Applicants are responsible for providing proof of enrollment by **Sept. 15, 2020** to receive payment.
- 3. Scholarship amount of \$1,000 will be submitted as a one-time payment directly to the bursar office of the recipient's school after proof of enrollment is received.

Children of Oklahoma AgCredit employees or directors or children of CoBank directors are NOT eligible for this scholarship.
